Water Shortages


- Water Costs in 2007

BROTHER What we had observed


Also observed

- Earlier & more compressed vintages
- Higher alcohols
- Increased colour in whites
- Decreased colour in reds
- More sunburn
- Decreased grape acidity



European warming predicted by the Hadley Centre model




BROTHOlistic Company Approach

- Convincing data that this is not cyclical, it is a fundamental change
- Needed to accept that this is happening, and plan accordingly
- Long planning horizon with vineyards
- Board resolution "accepts a 2°C temperature increase and factors this into the decision making process for all capital projects"








